Gender test racket busted at Hansi hospital

HISAR, JULY 28 A team of the Health Department busted a racket involved in the prenatal gender determination of foetus at Hansi town in the district today.

The team seized the ultrasound machine and related records from Dattarwal Hospital and lodged a complaint with the police.

A member of the team, Dr Kamid Monga, said they got a tip-off about gender tests being conducted at the hospital. They formed a team, comprising Dr Prabhu Dayal, Dr Kamid Monga, and two other personnel Ankit, Ajay, to unearth the illegal activity. Dr Monga said they sent a decoy customer to the hospital last night and then conducted a raid.

Dr Monga said the decoy customer was tested for gender determination of the foetus on July 23 and was told to collect the report from a tout on Wednesday. The tout Geeta, who is also employed as a nurse in the hospital, was caught when she took the money from the decoy this morning.

The team then visited the hospital and lodged a complaint with the police.

Delay in updating MIS portal may hit transfer of subject teachers

KARNAL, JULY 28 With the opening of online transfer drive by the Education Department, teachers have started filling their choices of stations, but delay in updating subjects allocated to students on MIS portal, may affect the drive for specific subject teachers, said an official of the department.

Rationalisation of teachers is done only after the updating subjects allocated to students on the management information system (MIS) portal, which is still pending of scores of students.

As per the data collected by *The Tribune*, around 20 per cent of the updation work has not been done by the schools across the district. Due to this, problems can be faced by teachers during transfer as the options for their choice of stations may be reduced for specific subject-wise posts.

Besides, due to delay in updating, proper mapping of schools with subject-wise teachers' requirement could not be done, that might result in vacant posts.

The data says, there are 77,767 students from Class VI to XII. Of them 36,918 are between Classes VI and VIII while 23,312 are in Classes between IX and X, and

17,477 are in Classes XI to XII. Sources said maximum difficulty is arising in the updating data of students of IX and XI because the admission process is still going on, which will continue till July 31.

One of the teachers said the updation of subjects allocated to students is already running behind schedule. It

should have been done earlier, before the opening of the transfer drive.

The delay in updating data may decrease the posts of any subject, another teacher said. He further said the posts of guest teachers were considered as vacant posts. Firstly, the station will be allocated to regular teachers and for the

remaining vacant posts, the guest teachers will be adjusted, he said.

Rohtash Verma, District Elementary Education Officer (DEEO), said around 20 per cent data was yet to be updated, but it would not affect the transfer drive much. He has directed the heads and teachers to update the data by July 29.

Hooda for solution to waterlogging in fields

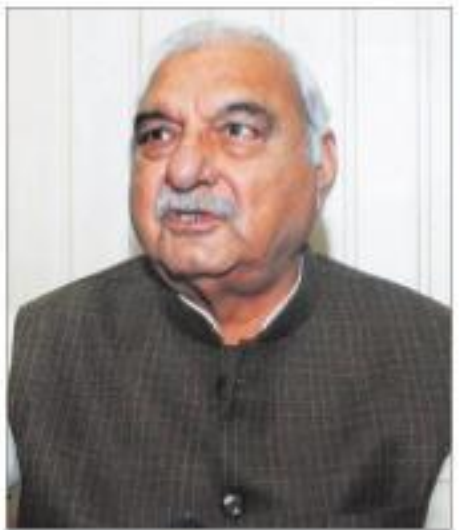
CHANDIGARH, JULY 28 Former CM and Leader of Opposition Bhupinder Singh Hooda today demanded an immediate solution to the problem of waterlogging in fields.

Hooda said farmers in many areas of the state, including Kaithal, Hisar, Bhiwani, Ambala, Sirsa, Rohtak, Jind, Sonapat, Kurukshetra, Karnal and Fatehabad have been hit by the problem of waterlogging.

"Thousands of acres of farmers' crops have been submerged. More than a week has gone by but the government has not taken any steps for draining out the water from the fields. Due to the rains in the past few days, thousands of acres of paddy, cotton and jowar crops have been severely damaged. Heavy rains have been forecast in the coming days. In such a situation, the farmers fear that this problem may amplify in the coming days," Hooda said.

Hooda expressed fears that a large part of the farmer's crop would get waterlogged due to the weather and neglect of the government, if the situation continued and the government did not take any immediate steps to bring relief to the farmers. "This will have a major impact on the production of crops, including paddy, cotton, sugarcane and jowar. This is going to add to the problems of the farmers who are already facing huge losses," he said.

He said the government should immediately get the girdawari done and give compensation to the farmers. He



said proper drainage system should be built at the earliest so that the farmers can be saved from further losses.

"Data that came out in the public domain recently showed that insurance companies have made a hefty profit of Rs 40,000 crores in just 5 years when the farmers are constantly facing losses. To make matters worse, the government has also increased the insurance premium for many crops. The premium amount per acre for paddy has been increased from Rs 713.99 to Rs 749.69, for cotton from Rs 1731.50 to Rs 1819.12, for Bajra from Rs 335.99 to Rs 352.79 and for Maize from Rs 356.99 to Rs 374.85. Every season the premium is deducted from the farmer's account without his consent, but neither the government nor the company come forward to give the compensation," he stated.

Hooda said the committee on agriculture in the Congress Navsankalp Manthan Shivir at Udaipur had also mentioned the crop insurance scheme and its recommendations. The committee formed under Hooda's leadership had recommended that the government should take up the work of crop insurance.

4 arrested for fraud; sent to three-day police remand

KAITHAL, JULY 28 The Kaithal police have arrested four persons for allegedly cheating people on the pretext of providing them loan. They have created a website which looks like the website of Mudra scheme of the Union Government. They have been taken on three-day police remand, said DSP Vivek Chaudhary.

The police are determining the involvement of others in this case and also the number of people they have cheated so far.

Giving details, the DSP said on the directions of the Superintendent of Police (SP) Maqsood Ahmed, a case of cyber fraud has been registered at the cyber police station in Kaithal, where Deepak of Garhi Padla village in the district was defrauded.

The cyber police team

arrested the accused from Hisar. They have been identified as Amit, Rahul, of Jind district, Geeta Ram and Ramesh of Bhiwani district, the DSP said.

Deepak alleged that he wanted to get a loan to set up a business. He googled for Mudra scheme and found a number.

When Deepak contacted on the number, a person assured him of a loan, for which he had been told to send Aadhar, PAN cards and bank details. The person, whom he contacted, told him that his loan of Rs 1.5 lakh had been sanctioned and asked him to deposit some money for file charges, insurance and others.

4 held for cow smuggling

GURUGRAM, JULY 28 A cow protection team chased two vehicles of smugglers for 2 km and caught four persons from near Panchgaon on the Kundli-Manesar-Palwal (KMP) expressway today.

The team rescued 26 animals and three dead animals from two vehicles of the smugglers. A pistol was also recovered from them. An FIR was lodged at the Bilaspur police station and cops began investigating the matter.

According to the complaint filed by Sahil, a resident of Mohammadpur Jharsa village and associated with the Bajrang Dal and Gau Raksha Dal, information was received that cattle smugglers in a truck and Tata 407 would come from the Delhi side on the KMP and go towards Palwal.

"On getting the information, a naka was set up and the accused arrested.

The police reached on spot and took the accused in custody. The accused were identified as Shaukeen, Mush-taq, residents of Ali Meo village, Imran, a resident of Satputiyaka village, and Aarif, a resident of Machroli village in Nuh district.

The FIR was registered under Sections 429 (mischievous by maiming or killing cattle) of the IPC, Sections 11, 13 (1), 13 (2) of the Animal Cruelty Act and Section 25-54-59 of the Arms Act at the Bilaspur police station.
